





Interview with Kishore Mahbubani:

There is no reason to fear China.

The pandemic is compounding the West's loss of power, says Kishore Mahbubani, a Singapore political expert. The US and Europe should give up the illusion that they can change China. Beijing vigorously defends its interests as any other superpower does. A mild superpower - that would be a contradiction in terms. Thanks to its economic rise, the People's Republic has become more self-confident. But China has not waged a war in over 40 years; it has not fired a bullet across its border in 30 years. No war started in Iraq. But China has not become militarily aggressive - although it is now also a military power. China is not planning any conquests. But there are also red lines for China's government, just take Taiwan as example.

China and USA agree to cooperation

The United States and China unveiled a deal to ramp up cooperation tackling climate change, including by reducing methane emissions, protecting forests and phasing out coal. The framework agreement was announced by U.S. climate envoy John Kerry and his Chinese counterpart Xie Zhenhua at the U.N. climate conference in Glasgow, and was billed by both as way to tip the summit toward success.

The climate cooperation between Beijing and Washington is primarily symbolic

The declaration of the USA and China on cooperation shows the special point about the climate policy: Climate change is a global crisis that requires international cooperation. Despite the harsh tone between the two countries, commentators always emphasized that they had a common interest in this policy area. Now this declaration sends a symbolic signal to the other countries to advocate tougher climate measures.

IOC praises China for delivering promises on carbon neutral Games




