


## **Editor's Letter**



# China plans to deliver 110 million doses of Covid vaccine to COVAX by the end of October

By the end of August, about 800 million doses of Chinese vaccines have been delivered to more than 100 countries around the world, especially developing countries. China is fulfilling its commitment to make Chinese vaccines a global public good in practice and will continue to do so. Sinopharm and Sinovac will deliver 110 million vaccine doses to the vaccine distribution system COVAX by the end of October.


## Why many scientists say it's unlikely that SARS-CoV-2 originated from a "lab leak"


#### Ten years of the China-Europe freight train: innovation and quality
